## Farm Stand Objectives

- The farm stand is part of an overall campus entrance redesign to include an informational kiosk and landscaping to attract pollinators and beneficial insects for vibrant farm and orchard food production.
- Create an inviting and inclusive stopping place to rest, shop, work and learn about regenerative agriculture.
- Make fresh, local food and other goods available to the community. The location is on the Island Transit bus route and there is plenty of parking on the campus.
- Provide farmers a selling venue beyond the Farmers' Market season which is Sundays, May to mid-October.
- Low-income shoppers may be able to use Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP) cards at the market and farm stand, receive up to \$40 additional value for purchases.
- Training venue for interns to learn the operation and management of a farm stand.
- The farm stand will expand as funds become available to include cold storage, shelter from sun and wind and a picnicking area.
